### **VIC SMITH TUESDAY NIGHT TRIALS**

#### **Series Three**

**June 11, 2024 - June 18, 2024, - June 25, 2024 - July 02, 2024 - July 9, 2024**

#### **CHECK IN:**

All boats must check in with the race committee on VHF channel "71" **before 1745 hrs** on the night of the race. The race committee will make an announcement on VHF channel "71" when they are on station and ready for check ins around 1730 hrs. **Please NO check INS during the starting sequences!** R/C will be on station at the south jetty opposite the green return light on the detached break wall. The "wake up" will be at 17:49.30 hrs and signaled from the race committee by sound and VHF radio, channel 71. The race will end at 2000 hrs! Those boats that do not finish the race will be scored as DNF. The race committee may shorten the race due to weather and will make announcements on VHF radio, channel "71" before the wake-up call. **WE ASK THAT AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED THE RACE, PLEASE STAY CLEAR OF THE FINISH LINE ALLOWING OTHER COMPETITORS TO FINISH.**

**COMPETITORS IN ALL CLASSES MUST DECLARE AT THE START OF THIS SERIES IF THEY PLAN TO USE A SPINNAKER SAIL!**

#### **ORDER OF START:**

There will be three classes:

(A) Class starts at 17:55 hrs.

(B) Class starts at 18:00 hrs

(C) Class starts at 18:05 hrs.

Your start is based on your PHRF rating and will go as follows:

(A): 000 to 100.

(B): 101 to 160.

(C): 161 to xxx.

**If you do not start with your class, you will be scored DNC.**

#### **SCORING:**

The race committee will use atomic time on PHRF Time over Time using your (W/L) rating. This series will be scored based on "with spinnaker" ratings. If you will not be using a spinnaker in this series, please notify race committee at [mdrvmf@gmail.com](mailto:mdrvmf@gmail.com) prior to the start of the series.

This is our regular race season so there will be awards given out for this series. Trophies are awarded as follows: 1st place, 2nd place and over all class winners. Overall winners will have two awards given for 1st and 2nd Place. The perpetual trophy will be given to those who scored the highest point overall

for each class. Awards will be given out at our end of our season annual awards party. Race results will be posted on our website at [www.mdrvmf.com](http://www.mdrvmf.com) after the event for public viewing.

**START & FINISH LINE:**

The starting line will be an imaginary straight line between the orange flag off the south Ballona Creek Jetty (aka Playa del Rey Jetty) and the green return navigation light on the south side entrance of the detached break wall.

The finish line will be a straight line from the green return light on the south side entrance of the detached break wall and the orange flag off the south Ballona Creek Jetty (aka Playa del Rey Jetty).

Approximately 30 seconds before your finish, you must announce your approach with name of vessel to our race committee on VHS "71." Our race committee will be on station to take your time and will signal your finish with a sound. If the race committee decides to shorten the course, they will make an announcement on VHF Channel "71" for the following weather marks:

**COURSE:**

**COURSE 1:** From the start line, go through the south entrance staying inside of the detached break wall and exit out the north entrance heading toward mark (S), passing it to port and then heading back to the south entrance of the harbor. Go through the south entrance staying inside of the detached break wall and exit out the north entrance heading toward (H) mark, passing it to port and head to the finish line at the south entrance of the harbor.

**COURSE 2:** From the start line go through the south entrances staying inside of the detached break wall and exit out the north entrance heading toward (H) mark, passing it to port and then heading to the south entrance of the harbor. Go through the south entrance staying inside of the detached break wall and exit out the north entrance and heading toward (SS) mark, passing it to port and then head to the finish line at the south entrance of the harbor.

**COURSE 3:** From the start line go through the south entrances staying inside of the detached break wall and exit out the north entrance heading towards (H) mark, passing it to port and then head to the finish line at the south entrance of the harbor.

**PROTEST:** As this series is intended to be fun, we strongly discourage any protests. RC must receive protest no later than one (1) hour after your finish. This changes rule 61.3. Regarding arbitration, Appendix T will apply.

**RULES:** The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) will govern The Race
